

## What about SIN?

To sin means to 'Miss the mark'. Missing the mark with God happens when we do not do as He says, hence we 'Break His commands', thus we sin. "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God," - Romans 3:23 After you have become a Christian there may be times that you sin again. This requires repentence (Changing your mind about the direction of moving away from God), confessing your sin and asking God for forgiveness. "If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us." -I John 1:6-10 The Apostle Paul shared how he felt about his endeavor to get to heaven; "Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind" -Philippians 3:12-15. We need to strive to be faithful because if sin becomes "Willful" (Deliberately going away from God) there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins.

Becoming Christ-like is a process. Jesus told Nicodemus not to be astonished at the idea of being "Born again". God wants us to have a fresh spiritual start with a new birth. He said to Nicodemus in John chapter 3 that "We must be born again of water and spirit to enter the Kingdom of God" (The church). When we are baptized (Emersed) in water for the "Answer of a good conscience towards God" (I Peter 3:21) we are 'Circumcised of heart' (Spirit) and we are added to God's family as newborn babes in Christ. We feed on "The pure spiritual milk of the word" (I Peter 2:2) as we grow. Eventually we partake of spiritual meat of the word and grow in understanding of God. Turning back to the ways of the world from God's ways results in our being lost again forever. (Hebrews 6:4-6, 10:26-27) God is not pleased if we do not grow up from the elementary principles of Christ. He wants us to grow up and mature spiritually so that we are like Christ, who is like the Father. It all starts with "Obeying the Gospel", which is following the "form" of the

Gospel that Jesus gave us. (Romans 6:17)

Jesus passed through the heavens to die and become the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all mankind. The good news of this redemptive act is called 'The Gospel'. "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." -Romans 3:23 We are all in need of forgiveness of our sins. Jesus' blood can perfect us when we 'Obey the Gospel'. "For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified." - Hebrews 10:14
