First Marriage Genesis 2:19-25

One man & One woman Suitable for each other **Helper comparable** Woman taken from the Man God brought the woman to the man Man leaves Father & Mother (Husband Wife) perpetuating pattern Joined to his wife (cling, cleave) **Become one flesh** No shame

Mark 10 & Matthew 19

Both Gospels recording the same event Pharisees were trying to trick Jesus

The "Lawful" they asked about was Moses Law

- **—**Jesus said "What did Moses command you?
- They said Moses permitted divorce with a certificate
- The precept was regarding "Pre-marital" fornication (Duet. 24:1-4)
- "It was not "Any and Every"

They have taken a precept of law and became liberal with it

Ephesians 5:22-33

- This is a <u>Great Mystery</u>

"For the woman who has a husband is bound by the law to her husband <u>as</u> <u>long as he lives</u>.
