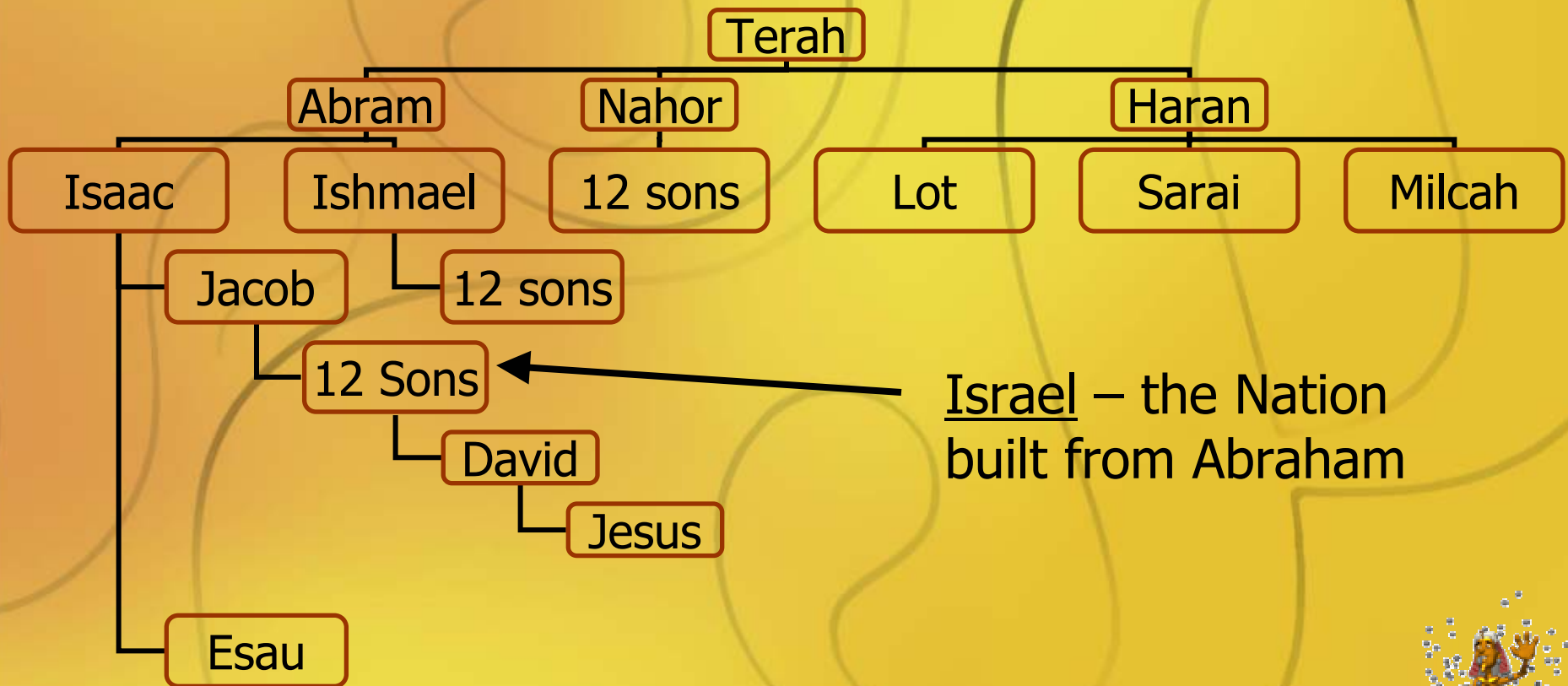

Moses & Law

- Adam brought sin onto the world
- Sin spread over the earth, God was sad
- God washed the whole earth of its sins and saved Noah
- God started over again to have His Righteousness on the earth
- Nations arose, God wanted a Nation for His name
- God Chose Abraham because of His Faith
- God made a Covenant with Abraham & made Promises
- Abrahams descendants grew and became great in Egypt
- 430 years passed and God chose Moses to lead Israel out of bondage and give them the Holy Land promised Abraham
- God gave them a Law:
 - Priesthood, Tabernacle, Ordinances, Holy Days

Moses & Law

- Joseph comes to Egypt ahead of Brothers & Israel (Jacob)
- Israel grows large, Egypt bears no children, Ban on males
- Moses is born, hidden by faith, set into basket, raised in Pharaohs house
- Moses can't stand to see Israel suffer, kills a man, flees to Midian
- Marries Zipporah, has a son, sees burning bush & approaches
- "I AM" sent you, signs, returns to Egypt, Pharaoh refuses
- 10 plagues, Passover, 1st born death, Lamb, blood, judgment
- Crossing the Red Sea,, Bread, water
- Mt. Sinai, Law given, build Tabernacle, Wander 40 years
- Numbered by census, taught war, under 20 die, Moses dies
- Cross the Jordan, Take the Promised Holy Land
- Serve God in cycles, rebellious/stiff-necked people, idolatry, bondage

Covenant

- There are two sides to a Covenant
 - Deuteronomy 6:5-17
- When man keeps his part it is righteousness to him
 - Deuteronomy 6:20-25
- God will not forsake His part
 - II Chronicles 6:14
- Israel failed to keep their part
 - Jeremiah 31:31-32
- God fulfilled the covenant in Jesus
 - Matthew 5:17-18
- God gave a New Covenant
 - Hebrews 7:12, 8:7,13



Law – Man's part

- Lots of types of Laws
 - Marriage (Oldest)
 - Law of sin
 - Moses
 - Jesus
- Law speaks to those in that Covenant
 - Romans 2:12, 3:19-20, 7:1-3
- Sin is "Lawlessness"
 - I John 3:4
- One sin = guilty of all
 - James 2:10-11
- Law is Good, but Weak
 - Romans 7:9-14, Hebrews 8:7 (not faultless)
- Law brings wrath
 - Romans 4:15
- We are not without law, but under law of Faith (Grace)
 - Romans 3:27-31

Is a Christian to Obey the 10 Commandments?

- Given to Israel only
 - Deuteronomy 5:1-4
- Israel did not keep it
 - Jeremiah 31;31-32
- God promised to replace it
- Jesus fulfilled it, Obsolete, “Until John”
 - Hebrews 8:13
- Paul said you are a debtor to keep it all
 - Galatians 5:3
- It cannot justify us
 - Galatians 3:11
- NO, we are not



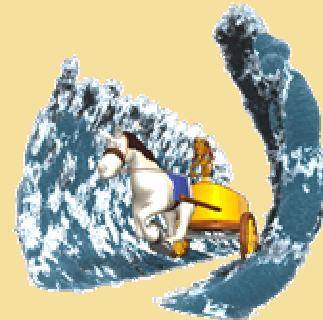
How does the Law help a Christian?
