






Adam & Sin


- There are two sides to a Covenant








Rightly Dividing the Truth

- Christ gave himself for her


















































Obey the Gospel


- Jesus of Nazareth, <u>a Man</u> attested by God to you

 - Acts 2:33


But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered.


