"Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth."




Rightly Dividing

- Orthotomeo to make a straight cut, dissect correctly
 - From <u>orthos</u> right arising perpendicularly erect

AND


 From tomoteros – to cut decisively, as if by a single stroke, whereas that implies repeated blows, like hacking



Rightly Dividing

- Properly ascertain what pertains to the old
- Let the New explain the Old
- Adhere to the New
- Interpret based on Truth




